1. The Permanent Representative of Israel to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to the Secretary-General's note No. LE 113 (22-2) of 16 February 1982 and his report (A/38/355), has the honour to state the following.
2. The reply of Yemen contained in the Secretary-General's report is nothing but an excuse for one more scurrilous attack on Israel, which is rejected out of hand.
3. It is requested that this note be circulated as an addendum to the Secretary-General's report.
