PROMOTION AND PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Status of the International Covenants on Human Rights

Report of the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, in its resolution 2200 A (XXI) of 16 December 1966, adopted and opened for signature, ratification or accession the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.

2. Both Covenants and the Optional Protocol were opened for signature at New York on 19 December 1966. In accordance with their respective provisions, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights entered into force on 3 January 1976, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 23 March 1976 and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, having received the required number of ratifications or accessions, entered into force simultaneously with that Covenant on 23 March 1976.

3. The General Assembly, in its resolution 44/128 of 15 December 1989, adopted and opened for signature, ratification and accession the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, aiming at the abolition of the death penalty, and called upon all Governments in a position to do so to consider signing and ratifying or acceding to the Second Optional Protocol.

4. The Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 11 July 1991, three months after the date of deposit with the Secretary-General of the tenth instrument of ratification or accession.

In its resolution 2002/78 of 25 April 2002, the Commission on Human Rights, inter alia, 5. appealed strongly to all States that had not yet become parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights to do so, as well as to accede to the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and to make the declaration provided for in its article 41; invited the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights to intensify systematic efforts to encourage States to become parties to the Covenants and, through the programme of advisory services in the field of human rights, to assist such States at their request in ratifying them or acceding to them with a view to achieving universal adherence; acknowledged the important contributions of the Human Rights Committee and the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights towards furthering the interpretation of the rights in the Covenants; encouraged States parties to limit the extent of any limitations that they lodge to the International Covenants on Human Rights, to review any reservations with a view to withdrawing them, to formulate any reservations as precisely and narrowly as possible and to ensure that no reservation is incompatible with the object and purpose of the relevant treaty or otherwise contrary to international law. The Commission also stressed the importance of avoiding the erosion of human rights by derogation and underlined the necessity for strict observance by States parties of the agreed conditions and procedures for derogation under article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the need for States parties to provide the fullest possible information during states of emergency, so that the justification for the appropriateness of measures taken in those circumstances could be assessed. The Commission further urged States parties to fulfil in a timely manner their reporting obligations under the International Covenants as may be requested and to make use of gender-disaggregated data and stresses the importance of taking fully into account a gender perspective in the implementation of the International Covenants at the national level, including in the national reports of States parties and in the work of the Human Rights Committee, the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and all other treaty bodies; it also urged them to take duly into account, in implementing the provisions of the Covenants, the observations made at the conclusion of the consideration of their reports by the Human Rights Committee and by the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, and stressed the need for more effective follow-up to the concluding observations. The Commission requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its fifty-ninth and sixtieth sessions a report on the status of the International Covenants and the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, including all reservations and declarations.

6. As at 1 December 2003, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 148 States; the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 151 States; the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 104 States; and the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 51 States.

7. Upon ratification of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights or subsequently 48 States made the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee established under article 28 of the

Covenant to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article. No inter-State communication under article 41 of the Covenant had been filed as of the date of the present report.

8. Under the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, as of the date of the present report, the Committee had registered over 1,229 communications and adopted final decisions on the merits ("Views" under article 5, paragraph 4, of the Optional Protocol) with respect to 436 of them.

9. The Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, at its twenty-eighth session (29 April-17 May 2002) held a meeting with States parties to the Covenant at which its working methods were discussed. At the same session the Committee held a day of general discussion on the equal right of men and women to the enjoyment of all economic, social and cultural rights as enshrined in article 3 of the Covenant. It also adopted a Statement to the Commission on Sustainable Development acting as the Preparatory Committee for the World Summit for Sustainable Development (Bali, Indonesia, 27 May-7 June 2002). At its twenty-ninth session (11-29 November 2002), the Committee considered and adopted a general comment No. 15 on the right to water (articles 11 and 12 of the Covenant). At the same session the Committee and the Special Rapporteurs on economic, social and cultural rights of the Commission on Human Rights adopted a joint Statement "The Millennium Development Goals and economic, social and cultural rights". In 2003, the Committee held its thirtieth (5-23 May 2003) and thirty-first (10-28 November 2003) sessions at which it, inter alia, discussed draft general comment on article 3 of the Covenant (thirty-first session) and held its day of general discussion on the right to work (article 6 of the Covenant). It decided to adopt respective general comments at its thirty-second session (26 April-14 May 2004).

10. During its seventy-fifth session (8-26 July 2002), the Human Rights Committee appointed a Special Rapporteur for Follow-up on Concluding Observations. During the seventy-sixth (14 October-1 November 2002), seventy-seventh (17 March-4 April 2003), seventy-eighth (14 July-8 August 2003), and seventy-ninth (20 October-7 November 2003) sessions, the Committee heard progress reports by the Rapporteur on Follow-up and noted with appreciation that the great majority of the States parties had provided follow-up information to the Committee pursuant to rule 70, paragraph 5, of its rules of procedure. On 16 July 2002 (seventy-fifth session), the Committee adopted general comment No. 30 on reporting obligations of States parties under the Covenant. During the seventy-fifth and the seventy-sixth sessions, the Committee applied the new procedure for dealing with non-reporting States for the first time and issued provisional concluding observations.

11. The lists of the States parties to the Covenants and the Optional Protocols, the dates of their ratifications, accessions or successions, as well as the dates of entry into force of those instruments for each State appear in annexes I and II to the present document. The texts of the reservations and declarations made by the States parties to the above-mentioned instruments are available on the web sites of the United Nations Office of Legal Affairs, Treaty Section (http://untreaty.un.org) and the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (http://www.unhchr.ch).

^c Yugoslavia came into being on 27 April 1992 following the promulgation of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia on that day. Yugoslavia nevertheless advised the Secretary-General on 27 April 1992 that it claimed to continue the international legal personality of the former Yugoslavia, and to be a member of the international organizations of which the former Yugoslavia had been a member. It also claimed that all treaty acts that had been performed by the former Yugoslavia were directly attributable to it, as being the same State (see documents S/23877 and A/46/915). B. States parties to the Optional Protocol (104)
