UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In resolution 33/199 of 29 January 1979, the General Assembly invited the Director-General of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) to submit to the Assembly at its thirty-fourth session a comprehensive report on the results of the Tokyo round of multilateral trade negotiations.
- 2. In a letter dated 1 June 1979, by which he transmitted to the Secretary-General the report 1/ called for under resolution 33/199, the Director-General of GATT made the following observations:

"The report is fully comprehensive, covering all aspects of the negotiations. However, General Assembly resolution 33/199 places major emphasis on the interests of developing countries, and I therefore draw your particular attention to those sections of the report, and especially chapter VI of part II, which summarize the efforts which have been and are still being made to provide special and differential treatment in favour of developing countries."
