LETTER DATED 20 MAY 1969 ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL BY THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter No. 3360 of 29 April 1969, I have the honour to communicate to you, for the information of the members of the Security Council, the following:

On 16 May 1969, Cambodian national defence forces captured in the region of Phnom Malay, province of Battambang, four Thai soldiers - a major, a lieutenant, a second lieutenant and a sergeant - and seventy-two Thai civilians with three bulldozers and fifteen trucks. These Thai soldiers and civilians entered Cambodia in flagrant violation of our sovereignty and of our national territory to plunder the natural resources and install a "Khmer Serei" government.

I should be obliged if you would have the text of this communication circulated as a Security Council document.
