Letter dated 21 November 1988 from the Permanent Representative of  
Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 4 November 1988 (A/43/783-S/20260), I have the honour to report to you the following incidents in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 13 November 1988:

On 13 November 1988, at 1530 hours, Afghan armed forces fired one round of artillery that landed in Pasaid Khail area near Landi Kotal Khyber Agency. As a result, one child was killed and two women injured. (All were Pakistan nationals.)

On 13 November 1988, at 2030 hours, Afghan armed forces fired one round of artillery which landed in village Kafirkot near Khar Gali, between Landi Kotal and Torkham. As a result, three persons were killed and five injured.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was called to the Foreign Office at Islamabad on the morning of 20 November 1988, and a strong protest was lodged with him over the unprovoked attacks. He was asked to inform the authorities in Kabul that if such attacks did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on them.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 30, 72, 129, 133 and 136, and of the Security Council.
