LETTER DATED 17 FEBRUARY 1969 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government and further to my letter No. 363 of 16 January 1969 (S/8970), I have the honour to inform you that on 5 February 1969, at approximately 9.30 a.m., Khmer elements on patrol made contact with some twenty armed Thais violating Khmer territory in the region of Prek Mean, Koh Kong province.

The engagement resulted, in so far as the members of the Cambodian patrol are concerned, in the death of Private 2nd Class Sok Samoeun on the spot and in light wounds to two others.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
