CABLE DATED 2 MARCH 1969 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF  
EQUATORIAL GUINEA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I REITERATE MY TWO CABLES CALLING FOR THE IMMEDIATE AND URGENT WITHDRAWAL OF  
SPANISH FORCES STATIONED IN MY COUNTRY. THEY STILL CONTINUE TO COMMIT AGGRESSION  
AGAINST THE DEFENCELESS AFRICAN POPULATION. TWO AFRICANS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED BY  
SAID SPANISH FORCES. REQUEST URGENT DISPATCH MIXED UNITED NATIONS PEACE FORCE  
OF NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY SOLDIERS. HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.  
SIGNED, FRANCISCO MACIAS NGUEMA, PRESIDENT EQUATORIAL GUINEA.
