LETTER DATED 27 MARCH 1969 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, and further to my letter of 17 March 1969 (\$/9089), I have the honour to request an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the following complaint:

Grave and continual violations by Jordan of the cease-fire, the provisions of the United Nations Charter, and of international law, including:

(a) Armed attacks, armed infiltration and acts of murder and violenceby terrorist groups operating from Jordan territory with the official support,aid and encouragement of the Jordanian Government and armed forces;

(b) Firing across the cease-fire lines by Jordanian forces, and in particular the wanton shelling of Israel villages.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
