NOTE VERBALE DATED 30 AUGUST 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF MONGOLIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-CENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his letter No. PO 230 SORH (1-2) of 7 June 1968, has the honour to state the following.

The Mongolian People's Republic has supported and continues to support the just struggle of the Zimbabwe people for freedom and national independence. It firmly condemns the racist régime of the white minority in Southern Rhodesia and does not maintain any political, economic or other relations with the régime of Ian Smith and his allies, the Republic of South Africa and Portugal.

The Permanent Mission of the Mongolian People's Republic, which supports Security Council resolution 253 (1968) on the question of Southern Rhodesia, hereby declares that it is resolved to continue to implement it in future.

The Permanent Mission of the Mongolian People's Republic to the United Nations would be grateful if the Secretary-General would arrange for this reply to be circulated as a Security Council document.
