LETTER DATED 1 APRIL 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BARBADOS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have been instructed by the Government of Barbados to convey to Your Excellency an expression of the utter abhorrence with which the Government and people of my country view the the execution by the illegal régime in Rhodesia of three Africans notwithstanding their reprieve by Her Majesty the Queen.

A resolution condemning this action has already been unanimously passed by the Barbados House of Assembly and circulated among all Commonwealth Governments. My Government, however, considers it fitting to manifest even more positively its stand alongside the overwhelming body of world opinion in condemnation of the inhumane policies of the Rhodesian régime.

I have the honour to request that you circulate this letter as a document of the Security Council.
