LETTER DATED 2 APRIL 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ITALY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I wish to refer to the part of the statement made by the distinguished representative of Jordan at the 1409th meeting of the Security Council on Saturday, 30 March 1968, in which it would appear, by inference, that Israel is acquiring arms and military equipments from Italy (document S/PV.1409, p. 16).

In this connexion I have been instructed to make it known that the Italian Government has not granted any license for the sale of military supplies to Israel.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
