LETTER DATED 8 APRIL 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JORDAN ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to draw Your Excellency's attention to a new act of aggression by Israeli armed forces against Jordan in violation of the cease-fire resolution and the Security Council resolution No. 248 (1968) of 24 March 1968.

- 1. At 10.00 hours local time, on 8 April 1968, Israeli armed forces opened artillery fire on our positions across the Jordan River. Fire was ceased at 10.42 hours.
- 2. At 11.00 hours local time, an armoured Israeli battalion consisting of tanks supported by helicopters crossed the Jordan River in the area south of the Dead Sea entering the villages of: Addahil, Hamra, Feenan and Bana. Israeli paratroopers landed in the Wadi Feenan area east of the cease-fire sector.
- 3. At 11.45 hours local time, the Israeli forces resumed fire for eight minutes.
 A preliminary report shows that one house was blown up. The extent of damage and casualties is not yet available. This confirms once more the persistent Israeli policy of aggression.

I shall keep Your Excellency informed of all developments.

I request this letter to be circulated as a Security Council document. Please accept, etc.
