LETTER DATED 27 NOVEMBER 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government and further to my letter No. 8487 of 18 November 1968 (S/8903), I have the honour to inform you that on 15 November 1968, at about 6.30 a.m., elements of the United States - South Viet-Namese forces violated Cambodian territory and opened fire on a mixed Cambodian patrol some 100 metres inside Cambodia in the commune of BOSMON, district of Rumduol, province of Svay Rieng, killing on the spot:

One private, 2nd class, named OUK VAN

Iwo provincial guards named MEAS VEN and TORK SAM ATH.

I should be grateful if you would arrange to have the text of this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
