NOTE VERBALE DATED 28 NOVEMBER 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SUDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Sudan to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to convey to him, on instructions from the Sudan Government, that the Constituent Assembly of the Republic of the Sudan, at its session on 5 November 1968, resolved as follows:

"The Constituent Assembly strongly deplores the approval of the United States Government of the initiation of negotiations for the purpose of delivery of Phantom F-4 jets to Israel, an action which the Assembly considers in plain violation of Security Council resolution 242 (1967) of 22 November 1967, relating to the peaceful solution of the problem of the Middle East, which was adopted unanimously and with the concurrence of the United States of America.

"The Constituent Assembly regards this action of the United States as flagrantly aggressive towards the Arab Nation, unless these negotiations are stopped forthwith."

The Permanent Representative of the Sudan requests the Secretary-General kindly to arrange for the issuance of this communication as a document of the General Assembly and of the Security Council.
