NOTE VERBALE DATED 18 APRIL 1963 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF LUXEMBOURG ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note PO 230 SORH (1) of 11 Merch 1968 and to the previous notes of the same reference which he was good enough to send to the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Luxembourg concerning the implementation of resolution S/RES/232 (1966) on the question of Southern Rhodesia.

In his letter of 16 February 1967, published on 17 February 1967 under the symbol S/7764, the Permanent Representative of Luxembourg informed the Secretary-General of the United Nations of the measures taken by the Government of Luxembourg in pursuance of the aforesaid resolution of the Security Council.

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg has the honour to transmit to the Secretary-General the following supplementary information:

At this time there is no air traffic between Luxembourg and Southern Rhodesia and the Government of Luxembourg will not authorize the initiation of any such traffic.

By its note of 2 April 1968 the Permanent Mission of Belgium transmitted to the Secretary-General the statistics covering the special trade between the Union Economique Belgo-Luxembourgeoise (UEBL) and Southern Rhodesia and the total trade of UEBL broken down by country of origin and destination, for the commodities listed in resolution 232 (1966).

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg would be grateful if the Secretary-General would arrange for the circulation of this note as an official document of the Security Council.
