INDIA, PAKISTAN AND SENEGAL: JOINT DRAFT RESOLUTION

The Security Council

Having heard the statements of the representatives of Jordan and Israel,

Having considered the Secretary-General's note (S/8561),

Recalling its resolution 162 (1961) of 11 April 1961,

<u>Considering</u> that the holding of a military parade in Jerusalem will aggravate tensions in the area and will have an adverse effect on a peaceful settlement of the problems in the area,

1. <u>Calls upon</u> Israel to refrain from holding the military parade in Jerusalem which is contemplated for 2 May 1968.

2. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council on the implementation of this resolution.
