Calendar for the referendum and elections adopted by consensus on Friday, 23 February 2004, by the Office of the President of the Republic, the Government and the Bureau of the National Transition Council, in the presence of the Bureau of the Committee to oversee the implementation of the outcome of the National Dialogue

3. Review of the Electoral Code	January-April 2004	– Ad hoc Committee (Interior and Justice) – Government – CNT
4. Review of the organic laws (political parties, territorial authorities ...)	January-April 2004	– Ad hoc Committee (Interior and Justice) – Government – CNT
5. Electoral census	April-June 2004	CEMI
6. Referendum on the Constitution	October-November 2004	CEMI and Interior
7. Presidential and legislative elections	January 2005	CEMI and Interior

N.B.: Details concerning the holding of municipal elections as provided for under the National Dialogue will be provided later in the light of international assistance.
