REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
DEPUTY REPRESENTATIVES OF HUNGARY ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a note dated 27 May 1968 from the Permanent Representative of Hungary stating that the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic has appointed Mr. József Tardos and Mr. Endre Zádor as deputy representatives of Hungary on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this note constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
