REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
REPRESENTATIVE OF HAITI TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 21 May 1968 from the President of Haiti stating that Mr. Arthur Bonhomme has been appointed representative of Haiti for the presentation of the Haitian complaint to the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
