Letter dated 28 January 2004 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my predecessor's letter of 19 March 2003 (S/2003/355), transmitting a third report from Guatemala submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).

The Counter-Terrorism Committee has considered the report carefully, with the assistance of its experts, and has written to the Permanent Representative of Guatemala to the United Nations to set out its preliminary comments. Guatemala has been requested to provide a response in the form of a fourth report by 16 April 2004.
