LETTER DATED 11 JUNE 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter No. 3998 of 10 June 1968, I have the honour to inform you that in accordance with the great clemency of Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, Chief of State, on 10 June 1968 the Royal Government released the two members of the United States Armed Forces whom the Royal Khmer Armed Forces captured on board the Philippine tugboat which violated the territorial waters of Cambodia at Kaam Samnar Krom on 20 May 1968.

This action has been taken without conditions as a tribute to the memory of Senator Robert Kennedy.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for this letter to be circulated as a Security Council document.
