NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 AUGUST 1968 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to the latter's note PO 230 SORH (1-2) addressed to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Syrian Arab Republic, has the honour to state, upon instructions from his Government, that the Syrian Arab Republic's attitude toward the minority racist régime in Salisbury continues to be one of strong condemnation.

As stated in his note S/SRHO/13 of 13 February 1967 on the same subject, the Syrian Arab Republic has broken all commercial and economic relations with the racist régime in Salisbury and prohibited any exchange therewith direct or indirect. It has issued the necessary legislation considering non-valid any travel document delivered by this régime and cutting off any communication with Salisbury, including the right to overfly the Syrian Arab Republic.

The Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic would be grateful if the contents of this reply would be circulated as a document of the Security Council and seizes this opportunity, etc.
