Considers that the conclusion of bilateral and multilateral agreements between States sharing natural resources, in accordance with principle 2, is the appropriate method for regulating internationally matters relating to the conservation and harmonious utilization of such resources. Reiterates, in this context, its position that each country must have the right to choose freely the form of co-operation it wishes to enter into where the joint utilization of natural resources is concerned.

Union of Soviet Socialist Republics

While noting that the principles have the character of recommendations, the USSR believes that they have significant meaning for the development of international legal regulations relating to the environment and that their adoption by the General Assembly would have a positive effect on the formulation of such regulations.
