**LETTER DATED 3 DECEMBER 2003 FROM THE ALTERNATE
PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MEXICO ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE CONFERENCE ON
DISARMAMENT INFORMING THE LATTER ABOUT THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF GUATEMALA'S
DEPOSIT ON 26 NOVEMBER 2003 WITH THE GOVERNMENT
OF MEXICO, IN ITS CAPACITY AS DEPOSITARY OF THE
TREATY OF TLATELOLCO, OF THE GOVERNMENT OF
THE REPUBLIC OF GUATEMALA'S INSTRUMENT OF
RATIFICATION OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE
TREATY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR
WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN
(TREATY OF TLATELOLCO)**

I have the pleasure to inform you that, on 26 November 2003, the Government of the Republic of Guatemala deposited with my Government, in the latter's capacity as depositary of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, its instrument of ratification of the amendments to the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean (Treaty of Tlatelolco) to which OPANAL resolutions 268 (XII) of 10 May 1991 and 290 (VII) of 26 August 1992 refer.

I should be very grateful if you would arrange for the present communication to be published as an official document of the Conference on Disarmament.
