The Permanent Representative of the People's Republic of Mozambique to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him that, on 28 July 1988, South African soldiers attacked Mozambican forces in Maputo province and one of their soldiers was killed and some matériel captured. The South African authorities asked Mozambique to return the body of the dead soldier and the captured matériel.

This Mission requests that this information be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 36 and 73, and of the Security Council.
