Election of the Executive Director of the United Nations
Environment Programme

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, in section II, paragraph 2, of resolution 2997 (XXVII) of 15 December 1972, decided that the secretariat of the United Nations Environment Programme should be headed by the Executive Director of the Programme, who should be elected by the General Assembly on the nomination of the Secretary-General for a term of four years.
2. The present term of Mr. Mostafa Kamal Tolba as Executive Director of the United Nations Environment Programme expires on 31 December 1988.
3. In accordance with the above-mentioned provision, the Secretary-General wishes to nominate Mr. Mostafa Kamal Tolba to be Executive Director for a further four-year term, beginning 1 January 1989.
