LETTER DATED 18 OCTOBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to the letter addressed to Your Excellency by the Permanent Representative of Turkey on 13 September 1967 and reproduced in document S/8156 dated 15 September 1967, relating to the alleged violation of Turkish airspace by a Greek aircraft on 22 July 1967.

Upon instructions from my Government, I would like to inform you that following the formal protest lodged by the Turkish Government with the Greek Government in connexion with the above matter, the Greek authorities undertook a thorough investigation into the Turkish allegations. This investigation, however, revealed no violation of Turkish airspace by a Greek aircraft on 22 July 1967.

I would be grateful if you could have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
