

### I. Introduction

- 1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda items 131 and 132 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/58/579 and A/58/580, respectively.

# II. Consideration of draft resolution A/C.5/58/L. 60

At its 39th meeting, on 2 April, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled "Review of the Office of the Prosecutor at the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda and the International Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia" (A/C.5/58/L.60), which was submitted by the Chairman on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Australia.
