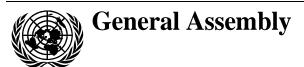

I. Introduction

- 1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 119 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/58/571 and A/58/571/Add.1.
