## United States of America: draft resolution

The Security Council,

Gravely concerned at the reports and complaints it has received of military hostilities in violation of the cease-fire between Israel and the United Arab Republic,

Convinced that progress toward the establishment of a just and durable peace in the area requires mutual respect for the cease-fire, in accordance with resolutions of the Security Council and the agreements of the parties,

- 1. Condemns any and all violations of the cease-fire;
- 2. <u>Insists</u> that the Member States concerned scrupulously respect the cease-fire as contained in resolutions 233, 234, 235 and 236 and the consensus of 10 July and co-operate fully with the Chief of Staff of the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization and the United Nations Military Observers in their tasks in connexion therewith;
- 3. Calls on the Governments concerned to issue categoric instructions to all military forces to refrain from all firing, as required by these resolutions.
