LETTER DATED 28 NOVEMBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Further to my letter dated 27 November 1967, I wish to inform you that on 24 November a Turkish jet aircraft violated Greek air space by flying over the Greek ship "PARALOS" lying in the territorial waters of Mytilini at a point $39^{\circ}11^{\circ}$ north and $26^{\circ}33^{\circ}$ east.

This new Turkish violation occurred at 1415 hours local time.

I would be grateful if you could have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
