LETTER DATED 2 DECEMBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to my previous communications concerning violations of Greek air space by Turkish aircraft, I have the honour, upon instructions from my Government, to inform Your Excellency that on 30 November 1967, at 1017 hours local time, a Turkish EPAR aircraft entered Greek air space in the EVROS region at a point $41^{\circ}00$ ' north and $26^{\circ}21$ ' east. It exited from Greek air space at a point $41^{\circ}02$ ' north and $26^{\circ}21$ ' east after having intruded at a depth of one nautical mile. Its speed was ninety nautical miles, and its altitude 500 feet.

A formal protest has been lodged with the Turkish Government for this new violation.

I would be grateful if you could have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
