April 2004, the Commission on Human Rights, having regard to the recommendations contained in document E/CN.4/2003/118 to encourage the voluntary biennial or triennial presentation of a significant number of thematic resolutions, decides to consider the issue of integrating the human rights of women throughout the United Nations system on a biennial basis at its sixty-first session, taking into account the outcome of the review and appraisal of gender mainstreaming that will be undertaken at the coordination segment of the substantive session of the Economic and Social Council in July 2004, and, accordingly, decides to request the Secretary-General to update his report (E/CN.4/2004/64) submitted under Commission resolution 2003/44 of 23 April 2003.
