LETTER DATED 8 NOVEMBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following my letter No. 5304 dated 4 November 1967, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency, upon instructions from my Government, that this morning, approximately ten Turkish fighters penetrated without warning deep into Greek air space, reaching the peninsular of Mount Athos and the island of Euboea, off the Greek mainland.

The Greek Government has lodged a formal protest with the Turkish Government for this new very serious violation of Greek air space.

I would be grateful if you could have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
