LETTER DATED 31 AUGUST 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE  
OF TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to the letter addressed to Your Excellency by the Permanent Representative of Greece on 18 July 1967 (S/8091) concerning two alleged violations of Greek air space by two Turkish aircraft on 15 July 1967.

I am instructed by my Government to inform you that the thorough inquiries carried out by the competent Turkish authorities as a consequence of the above-mentioned Greek allegations have shown that no Turkish aircraft violated Greek air space on the date mentioned in the letter of the Permanent Representative of Greece.

I would be grateful if Your Excellency would kindly have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
