LETTER DATED 19 DECEMBER 1967 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit herewith the text of resolution 2307 (XXII)* on the policies of apartheid of the Government of the Republic of South Africa, which was adopted by the General Assembly at its 1629th plenary meeting, on 13 December 1967.

In adopting this resolution, the General Assembly, in operative paragraph 4, "Once again draws the attention of the Security Council to the grave situation in South Africa and in southern Africa as a whole and requests it to resume consideration of the question of apartheid with a view to ensuring the full implementation of its resolutions and the adoption of more effective measures to secure an end to the policies of apartheid of the Government of the Republic of South Africa".
