At its ... meeting, on ... April 2004, the Commission on Human Rights, recalling its resolution 2003/71 of 25 April 2003, decides to request the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights and to invite the United Nations Environment Programme, within their respective mandates and approved work programmes and budgets, to continue to coordinate their efforts in capacity-building activities, in cooperation with other relevant bodies and organizations, and to request the Secretary-General to update the report on the consideration being given to the relationship between the environment and human rights as part of sustainable development and to continue to consider this question at its sixty-first session under agenda item 17, entitled “Promotion and protection of human rights: (d) Science and environment”.
