CABLE DATED 13 JULY 1967 ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF
THE UNITED NATIONS FROM THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE
ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES

In the absence of the Secretary General of the OAS and in accordance with Article 54 of the Charter of the United Nations I have the honour to transmit to you, for the information of the Security Council, the text in English and Spanish of the resolution adopted at the second plenary meeting of the twelfth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs, held on 10 July, concerning the establishment of a committee to prepare a report on events related to the so-called Afro-Asian Latin American Peoples' Solidarity Conference:

"The twelfth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs
Resolves:

1. To establish an eight-member committee to prepare a report on events related to the so-called Afro-Asian Latin American peoples' solidarity conference that have occurred since the report of 24 October 1966, presented by the Special Committee to study resolutions ii.1 and viii of the eighth Meeting of Consultation of Ministers of Foreign Affairs.
2. To authorize the President of the twelfth Meeting of Consultation to designate the States that should compose the aforementioned committee. 1/
3. To request the Secretary General of the Organization to give the committee the assistance it needs to achieve the objective stated above.

1/ The President of the Meeting designated Argentina, Colombia, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Peru, Trinidad and Tobago, and the United States."
