LETTER DATED 5 JULY 1967 FROM THE PERMAHENT REPRESENTATIVE OF JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government I have the honour to bring to Your Excellency's attention another act of aggression committed by the Israel authorities in the West Bank of Jordan.

It has been confirmed by reliable sources that the Israel authorities have taken away by force everything they found in all branches of Jordanian banks in Jerusalem, Nablus, Hebron, Jenin, Ramallah and Bireh presently occupied by Israel. They have also looted a considerable number of commercial stores.

In view of the seriousness of this Israel action, I am instructed by my Government to request that Your Excellency take all the necessary steps for the restoration of what has been illegally taken away from the above-mentioned Jordanian banks and stores and to ensure that such acts of banditry and lawlessness by the Israel authorities of occupation should not recur.

I shall be grateful if this letter is circulated as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly.
