LETTER DATED 7 JUNE 1967 FROM THE FOREIGN MINISTER OF ISRAEL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

At 4.45 o'clock p.m., New York time, I informed the Secretary-General of a telephone conversation with Jerusalem, informing me that the Israeli Government accepts the Security Council's call for an immediate cease-fire, provided that the other parties accept.

I have since received a cabled confirmation of this decision, which I now communicate to you officially.

We have been apprised of the Government of Jordan's acceptance and the ceasefire with that country has been in effect since 20.00 hours G.M.T.

We would welcome the announcement of acceptance by the other Governments involved in the hostilities.
