LETTER DATED 8 JUNE 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In view of the fact that fighting continues in the Middle East despite the unanimous adoption of two resolutions by the Security Council calling for a cease-fire and despite the indications of acceptance of a cease-fire by Jordan and Israel, I have the honour to request an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the present grave situation.
