1. At its 36th meeting, on 21 November 1988, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/43/28) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 10 of its report (A/43/775). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/43/SR.36).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 10 of its report (A/43/775), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1988-1989. The Secretary-General would undertake appropriate contacts and initiatives to encourage contributions to cover the cost of the activities proposed in the draft resolution.
