1. At its 23rd meeting, on 1 November 1988, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/43/23) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/43/L.12. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
