LETTER DATED 10 JANUARY 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REFRESENVATIVE OF BRAZIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to your note PO 230 SORH (1), of 17 December 1966, transmitting the text of Security Council resolution 232 (1966) on the question concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia.

- 2. In accordance with instructions received from the Brazilian Ministry of External Relations, I should like to inform you that the Brazilian Government, which does not recognize the present Government of Southern Rhodesia and does not provide it with arms, equipment and military matériel or with oil or petroleum products, shall comply with the relevant provisions of Security Council resolution 232 (1966) in accordance with Article 25 of the United Nations Charter.
