Subject: **Membership of the Central Review Board, Committee and Panel at Headquarters**

1. The mandate of the current membership of the Central Review bodies at Headquarters expired on 30 April 2004 and nominations from departments and offices and the selection list from the staff representative body had been requested to form the new membership. Normally, the Central Review bodies are constituted of equal number of members and alternates selected by the Secretary-General and by the staff representative body. However, it was not possible to achieve this in the light of a recent resolution from the Staff Council reiterating its decision to withdraw staff support for the Central Review bodies and not to comply with a request from the Office of Human Resources Management for selection of members and alternates.

2. As a temporary measure for the purpose of ensuring the continuation of the Staff Selection System, it has become necessary to invoke the provisions of sections 2.2 and 3.2 of Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2002/6, which state in part that should no final selection be made within two months of a written request or should the members and alternates selected by the Staff collectively not participate, the Central Review body concerned may nevertheless be constituted and discharge its functions when four members or alternates are present.

3. Accordingly, on the basis of the nominations received from departments and offices at Headquarters, the Secretary-General has approved the members and alternates on the following list and the formation of the Central Review bodies in accordance with the above-mentioned provisions of Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2002/6 until the Staff Council has submitted its own list of members and alternates for the Central Review bodies.

The Special Adviser on Gender Issues and the Advancement of Women or her representative will also participate in the Board and Committee, and the Panel as required, in an advisory capacity.

6. Mr. John Ericson will serve as Secretary of the Central Review Board and Mr. Bellarmine Ioannis will serve as Secretary of the Central Review Committee and Panel.
