LETTER DATED 12 OCTOBER 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
ISRAEL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to my letter to you of 10 October (document S/7536), I have the honour, on instructions from my Government, to request an urgent meeting of the Security Council on the following complaints by Israel against Syria:

1. Acts of aggression committed by armed groups operating from Syrian territory against the citizens and territory of Israel, in violation of the United Nations Charter and the Israel-Syrian General Armistice Agreement - and in particular the sabotage and mine-laying incidents of 7-9 October 1966.

2. Threats by Syria against the territorial integrity and political independence of Israel, and open Syrian incitement to war against Israel, in violation of the United Nations Charter and the Israel-Syrian General Armistice Agreement.
