Consideration of the draft articles on most-favoured-nation clauses

The General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Sixth Committee,

- (a) Takes note of the complexity of codification or progressive development of the international law on most-favoured-nation clauses:
- (b) Considers that additional time should be given to Governments for thorough study of draft articles and for determining their respective positions on the most appropriate procedure for future work including the forum for further discussion;
- (c) Decides to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-sixth session the item entitled "Consideration of the draft articles on most-favoured-nation clauses.
