The Council will have before it the report of the Governing Council of the United Nations Environment Programme on its eighth special session (Jeju Island, Republic of Korea, 29-31 March 2004).

The Governing Council of the United Nations Environment Programme reports to the General Assembly through the Council (Assembly resolution 2997 (XXVII), sect. I, para. 3). The Governing Council meets in regular sessions every two years in odd-numbered years and in special sessions in alternate years (Assembly resolution 53/242).

The Council will have before it report of the Secretary-General on products harmful to health and the environment. The report is submitted to the General Assembly, through the Council, every three years (Assembly resolution 39/229 and Council resolution 2001/33).
