I. Introduction

- 1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 119 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/58/571 and Add.1 and 2.
- 2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 51st meeting, on 3 June 2004. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/58/SR.51).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/58/L.92

- 3. At the 51st meeting, on 3 June, the Chairman introduced a draft decision entitled "Questions deferred for future consideration" (A/C.5/58/L.92).
- 4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/58/L.92 without a vote (see para. 6).
- 5. Before the adoption of the draft decision statements were made by the representatives of the United States of America, Uruguay, Australia, India, Egypt and Ireland (on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the European Union).

- (f) Note by the Secretary-General transmitting the report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the procurement of goods and services through letters of assist.⁶
