LETTER DATED 22 NOVEMBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In his letter dated 17 November 1967, which was circulated as Security Council document No. S/8249, the Chargé d'Affaires of Yemen complains of three violations of the air space of the Yemen Arab Republic by British aircraft between 7 and 9 November 1967. He further alleges that the aircraft opened fire.

The Yemeni complaints have been reported to my Government, who have thoroughly investigated them. I am happy to be able to say that, as has been the case with many similar allegations in the past, there is no truth in these charges.

I shall be grateful if you will arrange for this letter to be circulated as a Security Council document.
